



Old Bay Crab Dip Recipe

Ingredients:

- 1 package (8 ounces) cream cheese, softened
- 1 cup mayonnaise
- 2 teaspoons OLD BAY® Classic Seafood Seasoning
- 1/2 teaspoon McCormick® Ground Mustard
